## PROVISION FOR PARENTS

## BEHAVIOUR, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL

Social and emotional well-being groups - positive friends  
Yoga and POD counselling service  
Positive behaviour policy with opportunities to earn dojo points.  
Visual timetables and visual prompts used for securing a structured day for children with ASD  
Flexible or alternative curriculum for identified pupils  
Reward time and sticker/ record charts for identified children  
Behaviour mentor support and Pupil Support Room for reflection and restorative work  
Working in partnership with pupils and parents

## AFTER SCHOOL PROVISION

A variety of after school clubs run throughout the week during term time for all year groups.

## OUT OF SCHOOL PROVISION

Class trips  
Visitors to delivery aspects of the curriculum  
Local Educational and Health Services for specific support e.g. Community Education Psychologist (CEPs)
