	Subject	What are we learning this term?
Power Maths	PoWER	This term we will be focusing on numbers 1 to 10 and comparing weight, height and length. The children will be learning all about numbers 1 to 10 with a deeper understanding. This involves writing numbers, counting numbers, comparing numbers, whilst continuing to subitise numbers 1 to 5 (knowing the number of dots without counting). This term the children will be using ten frames and developing their number bonds to 10.
		Please help your children with learning their numbers 1 to 10 by recognizing numbers in their everyday life.
ics		This term in phonics the children will be practising their initial sounds in set 1 of the Read, Write, Inc scheme and developing their ability to read green words containing CVC words.
Phonics	Read Write Inc.	The children will be embedding their set one sounds and applying this knowledge to their reading. They will begin to read red ditty books containing set one sounds.
