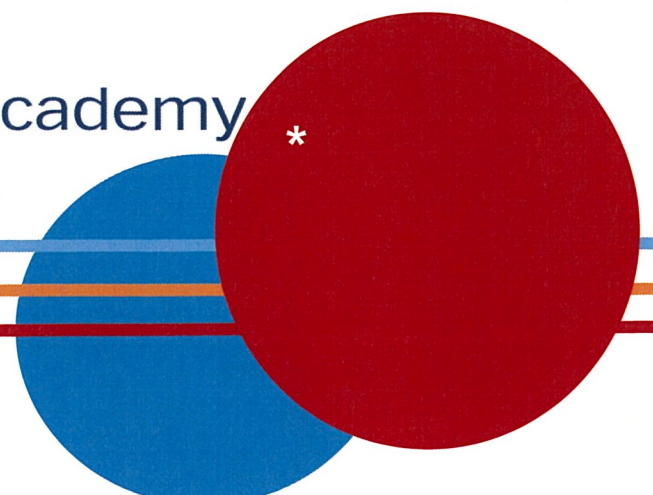

Jubilee L.E.A.D. Academy's Wrap Around Provision runs Monday to Friday during term time (not on inset days or when school is otherwise closed) and is open to all pupils attending the school.

Breakfast and After School	(All sessions)	£12

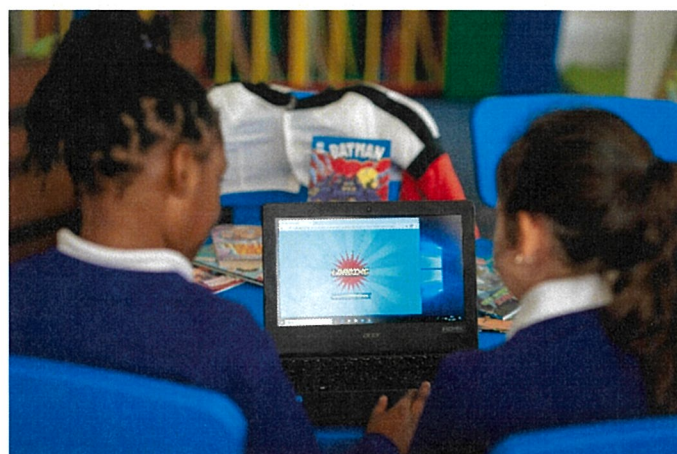

What we offer

Children are free to choose activities and resources as they wish on a daily basis. There will always be a selection of activities and resources available which may include dressing up, home corner, craft, board games, construction, physical play, reading, computers and homework, as well as focussed activities for after school provision which may include football, general sports, dance, gymnastics and art.

What we provide

The food we provide at the Breakfast Club includes, cereals, toast, bagels, fruit and many more choices. Milk and juice is available for the children to drink as well as water. The food for the After School Club is not intended as a substitute for a main evening meal. We provide a sandwich and snacks, including fresh fruit. We use fresh ingredients and follow statutory guidelines and sandwiches are prepared by the kitchen on a daily basis. Fresh drinking water is available at all times. We aim to meet individual dietary requirements and parental preferences wherever possible.
