	Subject	What are we learning this term?
Power Maths	POWER	In Maths this half term we are focusing on decimals, percentages, fractions and ratio. We will also continue to push harder on our arithmetic skills in preparation for SAT's. The children will be doing a lot of work in their strengthening and deepening books, covering a range of topics. The children are doing amazing so far, but any additional practice outside of school would be highly encouraged also.
English	The Journey by Transpose Source of the Hong type Books	This half term in English , we will be looking at a book called The Journey . This is a thought-provoking picture book as it offers a powerful exploration of themes such as resilience, family, and the impact of displacement, which encourage empathy and understanding of global issues. The book's illustrations and narrative provide opportunities for children to make inferences. The writing produced by this tends to be emotion filled and high in quality.
Curriculum		This term our History focus is Why could the Mayans be considered as a historical mystery? We are looking at the Mayan civilisation and understanding their beliefs and culture. In Geography this half term we are discovering what ways are North and South America similar and different. In Science we are learning about the circulatory system and the jobs of blood vessels. In RE we are deepening our understanding of The Muslm faith. In PSHE we explore ways in which we can manage money.
