| | Subject | What are we learning this term? |

| Power Maths | POWER | This term we will be focusing on numbers 1 to 20, numerical patterns and shape. The children will be learning all about numbers 1 to 20 with a deeper understanding. This involves writing numbers, counting numbers, comparing numbers, whilst continuing to subitise numbers 1 to 5 (knowing the number of dots without counting). This term the children will be using ten frames and developing their number bonds to 10. |
| Phonics | Read Write Inc. | This term in phonics the children will begin learning their set 2 sounds and by the end of Reception should be able to identify the sounds; ay, ee, igh, ow and oo ready for Year 1. The children will be embedding the sounds they know and will be continue to read these in simple sentences building their fluency. |
| Curriculum | How do I change over time? | This term in our afternoon lessons the children will be focusing on the Big Question 'How do I change over time?' The children will be learning all about how things change over time and what has happened in the past. Transition will be a big focus this term, and the children will be supported in upcoming changes and how to deal with emotions related to change. |
