Regular attendance is fundamental to the future success of children. We expect pupils to be in school for every session of the school day and for every day that the school is open. Our objectives are to promote good attendance, ensuring every pupil has access to the full-time education to which they are entitled. By acting early to address patterns of absence we aim to reduce absence, including persistent and severe absence.

#### **Persistently Absent**


Did you know if your child has 19 days of absence or 38 unauthorised late marks your child would be classed as being persistently absent which can be perceived as academic neglect.

Did you know late marks affect your child's attendance percentage? Pupils miss key information by arriving late which can cause your child to feel unsettled potentially affecting their learning.





Out of 323 pupils in school we have 50 pupils who have 100% attendance and are still in with a chance of winning the Nintendo Switch along with a treat afternoon in school!
