





YEAR 3 CURRICULUM – SUMMER TERM 2

Literacy		<p>In English, we will be reading <i>The Iron Man</i> by Ted Hughes.</p> <p>This exciting book describes the mysterious arrival of a giant “metal man” who comes out of the sea. It explores themes of prejudice, fearing the unknown and bravery.</p> <p>We will be writing a formal letter and a narrative piece of writing based around problem resolution using descriptive language and creating suspense.</p> <p>In Active English, we will be focusing on descriptive language techniques and letter writing structures.</p>
