Autumn 1 Who am I?	The Rainbow Fish – having difficulty sharing, understanding how good it feels to share Ruby’s Worry – dealing with anxiety, problem-sharing Giraffe’s can’t dance – accepting own, and others’, differences All are Welcome – themes of inclusion and diversity, set in a school
Autumn 2 What do I celebrate?	The story of Diwali – links to RE curriculum A stroll through the seasons – nature, seasons Stickman – developing resilience The Christmas story - RE curriculum
Spring 1 How do I change over time?	The Very Hungry Caterpillar – days of the week, lifecycles Pip and Egg - lifecycles Grandad’s Island – death, loss, journeys, different places Tad – growing up, being brave
Spring 2 Why is my world so amazing?	The Gruffalo – using your imagination, protecting yourself Monkey Puzzle – being lost, asking for help The Tiger who came to tea – overcoming problems cheerfully, being kind to others Dear zoo – vocabulary, play, paying attention, problem-solving Superhero like you – people who help us
Summer 1 How can I learn to sing in tune?	The singing Mermaid – being tricked, being helped (bad people, good people) The Easter Story – RE curriculum links Singing in the Rain - uplifting What the Ladybird heard – being quiet, finding your voice, being heard
Summer 2 How do I know where I am going?	Handa’s Surprise – different fruit, different animals We’re going on a bear hunt - onomatopoeia The koala who could – overcoming worries, dealing with change The snail and the whale – unlikely friendships, big ideas, help from unlikely source
