

## Reception – Curriculum Letter – Spring 2

	<b>Subject</b>	<b>What are we learning this term?</b>
<b>Power Maths</b>		<p>This term we will be focusing on ordering, identifying and comparing numbers 1 to 10. The children will be focusing on comparing weight, height and length using a variety of different mathematical resources. In reception this term we will be continuing to develop the children's understanding of subitizing (knowing how many without counting) and using a ten frame confidently.</p>
<b>Phonics</b>		<p>This term in phonics the children will be consolidating their knowledge of set 1 sounds and special friends of the Read, Write, Inc scheme and developing their ability to read green words containing CVC words. By the end of Spring 2 the children should know the first 35 initial sounds and 10 special friends, this will support them in reading simple words confidently.</p> <p>The children will be embedding their set one sounds and applying this knowledge to their reading. They will begin to read red ditty books containing set one sounds.</p>

### Why is my world so amazing?

This term in our afternoon lessons the children will continue focusing on the 'Big Question' Why is my world so amazing?

This topic explores people, animals, weather, landmarks from around the world and how they are similar/different to where we live.
