


## YEAR 3 CURRICULUM – SPRING TERM 2

Power Maths		<p>In Power-Maths this half-term we are learning to;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Find equivalent fractions.</li> <li>✓ Compare fractions.</li> <li>✓ Add and subtract fractions to make a whole.</li> <li>✓ Solve problems involving capacity and mass, including measuring mass in grams and kilo-grams and working out intervals.</li> <li>✓ Solving-problems involving; fractions, mass and capacity.</li> <li>✓ We will also be practicing all of our <b>timetables</b>.
