Dear Parents/Carers,

This is a key time for all pupils, however there is extra importance for those who are completing national assessments. In Year 1, pupils will complete their phonics screening checks, those in Year 4 will complete their multiplication tables check, and those in Year 6 will complete their end of Key Stage 2 SATs. Teachers have been working extensively throughout the year with your children in order to best prepare them and we always welcome your support in helping them to prepare in the final weeks before they take place. What we offer

Children are free to choose activities and resources as they wish on a daily basis. There will always be a selection of activities and resources available which may include dressing up, home corner, craft, board games, construction, physical play, reading, computers and homework, as well as focussed activities for after school provision which may include football, general sports, dance, gymnastics and art.



What we provide

The food we provide at the Breakfast Club includes, cereals, toast, bagels, fruit and many more choices. Milk and juice is available for the children to drink as well as water. The food for the After School Club is not intended as a substitute for a main evening meal. We provide a sandwich and snacks, including fresh fruit. We use fresh ingredients and follow statutory guidelines and sandwiches are prepared by the kitchen on a daily basis. Fresh drinking water is available at all times. We aim to meet individual dietary requirements and parental preferences wherever possible.
