	Subject	What are we learning this half term?
Maths		This term we will be adding to our Maths knowledge by learning about Fractions, Money and position and direction. Also we will be consolidating our knowledge of numbers to 100.
English	 <p>WHERE THE WILD THINGS ARE STORY AND PICTURES BY MAURICE SENDAK</p>	In English pupils will be reading the book Where the Wild Things Are. Pupils will use coordinating conjunctions, adjectives and verbs in their writing which will be inspired by the story. Pupils will also complete an independent write this term.
Curriculum		In <b>History</b> , we will be continuing with our learning about how Invention has changed our homes through time. In <b>Science</b> we be investigating Materials. In <b>Computing</b> we will be programming devices for a specific purpose. In <b>R.E</b> pupils will be learning about what festivals Jewish people celebrate.

- Please encourage your child to **play on SumDog** to help develop their Maths fluency, their SumDog logins are in their reading diaries.
