

JUBILEE – WORK PROJECT AND LEARNING MATERIALS

On Monday 4th May, we will be providing you with a brand new project and learning materials which your children can work on during the coming weeks.

These will be available for collection from school for those who can walk here as part of their daily exercise. For those who cannot walk to school, please contact the school office so that further arrangements can be made.

We are asking that you come to school to collect these under the following guidance:

- Where possible, only one person per family to come to collect them
- At all times, remain 2 meters apart from other people (including other families and staff)
- Only arrive at school within the designated timeslots
- You can only collect the work packs for your family at your address

Timeslots – Very Important

To reduce the time for anyone in a queue, we have allocated timeslots for each family. These will be based on family surnames and mean that you will be able to collect all of your children's packs in one visit. These are:

9am – 10am Surnames beginning with **A, B**

10am – 11am Surnames beginning with **C, D, E, F and G**

11am – 12pm Surnames beginning with **H, I, J, K and L**

12pm – 1pm Surnames beginning with **M, N, O and P**

1pm – 2pm Surnames beginning with **Q, R and S**

2pm – 3pm Surnames beginning with **T, U, V, W, X, Y and Z**

For families with containing more than one time slot, please use the surname which comes first alphabetically.
